



2021 Festival Referee Information Sheet

For the applicable festival rules refer to the linked information below.

Make sure you receive a game sheet signed by a team official from each team before the start of the game.

Enforce the retreat line (1/2 way line for U8s, and 1/3 line for U9s and U10s).

Be vocal on the field/talk to the players/tell them what they did right and/or wrong.

Play the entire game (2x20 for U8s and/or 2x25 minute halves for U9s and U10s).

There is no reason to play fewer minutes even if the score is one-sided.

However, allow water breaks during extremely hot weather.

Implement the 4Up1Up rule in one-sided games (games in which the winning team is up by 4 or more goals).

This rule is optional. The team officials from both teams must agree to its use.

The host club will pay you your game fees after you have completed all of your games and handed in all game sheets.

You would receive \$20 per U8 game(s) and \$25 per U9 and/or U10 game(s) officiated.
